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Supervising Physicians working with Healthstat worksite clinics must assist clinic providers in appropriately treating patients so that they reach personal health improvement goals. Supervising Physicians must be available to discuss medical situations presenting in the clinic with the clinic providers. Site visits to the worksite clinics and electronic chart review are also required (minimum requirements vary by state). Strong collaborative skills are necessary in order to make the best use of all resources available to employees. .

Required Competencies

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- Must be a Medical Doctor with specialty in Family Practice, Internal Medicine or Emergency Care with experience in Occupational Medicine.
 - Must have a minimum of 3 years of current practicing experience.
 - Must have a minimum of 3 years experience in the medical techniques available to lower health risks associated with chronic disease states.
 - Must meet and maintain all State licensing requirements.
 - Must be in good standing with the State Medical Board.
 - Must have a minimum of \$1,000,000/\$3,000,000 professional liability insurance coverage. Higher limits may be required, if required by the client.;
 - Must have experience in supervising patient care and treatment provided by a Nurse Practitioner and maintains State and Healthstat supervision requirements. Must maintain a Collaborative Practice Agreement with the Nurse Practitioner. This agreement must outline the demographics of the population, the scope of practice, quality assurance standards, and prescriptive authority. Must be an advocate of early detection and prevention of chronic disease states and support the concept of convenient, affordable access to healthcare.
 - As a general rule, the eligible physician cannot have committed a felony or misdemeanor, been sanctioned or suspended by Medicare or Medicaid, been subject to disciplinary proceedings or termination from previous employment due to the actions which caused the disciplinary charge, or had their license to practice medicine revoked, limited, restricted, reduced, suspended, denied or not renewed.
 - Must be able to record patient encounter data in the Healthstat Electronic Medical Record.
